Biblically speaking, a name expresses the content of the person who bears that name. His name is wonder and that means that is what he does. He performs wonders, miracles.

It can look dark, it can look impossible then there's no other option than the miracle. But think that is an option, think how fantastic, there's no other hope, yeah I can easily relinquish every other hope as long as I have this option.

All their thoughts and interests revolve around external things. If there is talk about miracles, people immediately think of something external—strictly external things.

Faith in the virgin birth ought to teach us and strengthen us to believe in wonders within us, that something divine can be born and created in heart and mind without the will or the strength of the flesh, without the will or the strength of man – by supernatural means – totally apart from our insufficiency and lack of power as human beings.

All our vain attempts do not prove that it is impossible; it simply proves that our own strength is insufficient. Because God does wonders—and He does them gladly—it succeeds anyway. Glory to God!

Do we have reason to believe in full victory, to the uttermost? Yes, believe in wonders, in miracles! Believe that one miracle will follow another—in your inner man!

Then something glorious and divine will come into being in your inner man, and this will necessarily result in miraculous results on the outside, in daily life, in the difficulties of life.

Believe in "virgin births!" In other words, man's power is utterly superfluous. Walk in this uninterrupted faith that wonders are occurring in your life, and you will not be disappointed! Then both you and others will constantly have reason to say, "Yes, it is truly a miracle."



Precisely through this, joy in hope it goes top speed forward and that is something very different than things looking hopeless. 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Believe like Abraham did

Not only did Abraham believe that God is, and that He is a mighty God, he also believed the things that God said to him! What he believed most firmly was that God would do what He had promised, even though it appeared to be totally impossible according to his understanding.

This is what it means to have the faith of Abraham, to be a child of Abraham.

Being our heavenly Father's children in the dispensation of the new covenant is to believe in all the words of life that Jesus spoke and the words that the apostles wrote in their letters, so that we are obedient to them—to everything that is written in the Sermon on the Mount and everywhere else in the New Testament (which, of course, is in perfect harmony with this famous message that Jesus Himself delivered) just as Abraham was faithful and obedient to God when he sacrificed his son Isaac! Read Romans 1:5 and 16:20; Matthew 28:20; Hebrews 5:9 and 2 Thessalonians. 1:5-10.

Truly believing in Jesus obviously means believing His Word and His promises. And this in turn includes believing unreservedly that we must fulfill the conditions so that the promises can be fulfilled! God said to Abraham, "Walk before Me and be blameless," or perfect and irreproachable! We see this perfect obedience when he was to sacrifice Isaac!!!

It is precisely the same in the new covenant with which Jesus came, only to a much, much stronger and deeper degree! "Therefore you shall be perfect, just as your Father in heaven is perfect." Matt. 5:48; Eph. 5:27; 2 Pet. 3:11 and 14.

If you do not believe Jesus' words about being obedient, then you are making Jesus out to be a liar and a false teacher, without actually saying it or meaning it. When you take this pointless stand, that is the result! By doing this, you have quite simply rejected Him! Then you have also, in fact, rejected His true and good and glad tidings, that is, His gospel, because it contains the message about obeying all His words in deed and in truth, about being transformed and re-created on the inside, about walking in His steps, about becoming like Him, about partaking of divine nature.

Almost everything in the New Testament is concerned with precisely this!!! If a person cannot see this, he must be—necessarily—

blind!!! And he is blind because of his unbelief in the Word. Therefore it is almost ironic

Every Word of God is true. God keeps every promise He has made. Therefore we should believe every single Word of life exactly and in its entirety. By fulfilling all the conditions without reservation, we will also obtain all His promises in their entirety. There are no exceptions. God is not partial. He cannot lie and He cannot fail. God's Word is the only thing that is completely reliable! Who then should not believe all of it?

What we have faith for will become true when we believe without doubting; then we will receive it. It cannot fail to come to pass. It may take some time, but it will come! He who humbles himself will be exalted! There is no way around it. It will happen as surely as God is alive. And if one dares to get conceited or, in other words, exalt oneself, then as surely as God is alive, he will be humbled! God will faithfully see to it. It is unavoidable!

"Give and it will be given to you" That means: from your heart and with joy. Then there is no other possibility than that it will be given to us. God Himself will see to it with a never-failing faithfulness! People fail first in one thing and then in another. There is no such thing with God

We can take all of God's words, all of the Words of life, as examples. They are fulfilled automatically without interruption. Why do most believers read so pitifully little and so pitifully superficially in God's Word? Because they either do not know or do not believe that it is fact. There is little help in reading the Word and in hearing it if one does not have a living faith in its unfailing reliability, or if one does not fulfill the conditions, or if one does not even know or see that there are conditions for everything that has been promised!
